For a complete and eligible NFP application, you must have the following documents:

- Employer statement **and** plan to implement the acquired knowledge (in **PDF** format) **note; fill in both pages, and submit it as 1 PDF!**
- Copy of valid passport (in **PDF** format)
- Government statement (in **PDF** format), if applicable.
- Motivation letters
- Your reference number: ATLS26516CDI. Please copy this reference number to your online application form.

We advise you to prepare all documents mentioned above very well before you start with the online NFP application.

Please note that you can submit your application through this link before **19/07/2016** and that you can only submit your NFP application through the online form once. **It is not possible to edit your application once it has been submitted.**

You will **not** get a confirmation email when your NFP fellowship application has been submitted.

After submitting your application

The number of NFP fellowship available is limited and admission to the course is on a competitive basis. It is not possible to check the status of your NFP application. The final selection of candidates will take place around **20/09/2016**. About two weeks thereafter CDI will inform you, on behalf of Nuffic, about the outcome of your NFP application.
